**Lesson:** God Gives Us What We Need

**Objective:** God gives us what we need when we love and trust God and share what we have.

**Story:** God Cares About You, attachment

- **Read** the story to your child/ren.
- What do you think is something beautiful in nature?
- Who does God care for? (Everyone)
- How can we help to be sure everyone has enough food and clothing? (share)

**Possible Activities to do with this lesson:**

1. Go on a nature walk. Take pictures of beautiful things you see in nature or of any birds you can find. Then, at home, draw a picture of what you saw and send it to Mary at [formation@washingtonparish.org](mailto:formation@washingtonparish.org).
2. Share kindness with others. Take time to draw a picture for someone you know or someone in need. Mail your picture to the person you made it for. If you would like to write to a church member who is home on their own, I have some people who would appreciate a note or card. Remind your kids that doing something for others is a way to share love.
3. If you go shopping online or otherwise, ask your child what one extra item you should buy to give to the church food shelf. Talk about how God asks us to share food with others. Give your child the chance to pick out a food item to be shared with others (even if you have to hold onto it for now!).
4. Make a Bird Feeder. I like these easy bird feeder options as there are some alternative ideas if you don't have bird seed at home! Talk about how we can share food with the birds and how God loves all creatures.

# God Cares about You



Don't worry too much about your food and drink and clothes," said Jesus.



"Look at the birds and the flowers. Our heavenly Father God takes care of the birds, and they all find food.

"And look how the wildflowers grow. God has made them look beautiful. They're as nice and colorful as a king's clothes.

"God gives us all we need when we love him and trust him and share with each other. Then there will be enough food and drink and clothes for everyone."

Later Jesus watched some sparrows as the tiny birds flew and hopped around and pecked at the ground.

"God knows and cares for everyone, even the tiniest of these sparrows," said Jesus. "God is great and mighty and powerful, but he knows every little bird. A little sparrow doesn't seem very important, but God knows if one falls to the ground. He knows us and cares for each one of us, too. We don't need to be afraid when we know we're safe in his strong, kind hands."
